

- COURSE MAP -





A tricky opening Par 3 to start, with trees to the left and out of bounds to the right and rear, with the added difficulty of the front right bunker and large tree protecting the approach to this elevated green.



This relatively long Par 3 presents a good scoring opportunity for those that are straight off the tee, but any wayward tee shots will be consumed by the rough and trees that run all the way along both sides of the hole.



Dog-leg right Par 4, with tree lined fairway and out of bounds to the left in the form of the River Ure, this is a real risk and reward hole for those who choose driver off the tee and attempt to straighten the hole.



This long Par 4 represents a real test of your technique, with straight shots being rewarded and anything wayward bringing the tree lined fairway and River Ure to the left into play. A tree in the centre of this narrow fairway and small stream running along the right-hand side, only add to the difficulty.



An uphill Par 3 to an elevated, sloping green presents a good scoring opportunity, but anything long will be consumed by the two greenside bunkers to the rear.



Straight drivers will enjoy this long Par 4, but with out of bounds left and fairway bunkers to the right, it isn't quite as easy as it may appear. A two-tier green, protected by front right and left bunkers, requires an accurate approach shot.



A relatively short Par 4 presents the chance of a good score, however any wayward drives to the right bring the fairway bunkers into play, and an elevated green protected by two greenside bunkers to the front right and left, are ready to collect anything short.



This long, dog-leg right Par 5 will reward those that hit a straight ball, but danger awaits all the way along, with out of bounds to the left, a stream that runs all the way along to the right and even a tree in the centre of the fairway to avoid.



An uphill Par 4, that often plays into the wind, has a large fairway bunker to the left and trees to both sides ready and waiting to collect any wayward tee shots. The elevated green requires a precise approach shot to avoid the three greenside bunkers.



This relatively short Par 5, that is often wind assisted from the tee isn't quite as straight forward as the yardage might suggest. A large fairway bunker to the right, tree lined fairway and large pond that runs all the way up to the front of the green, presents a real risk and reward challenge.



Dog-leg left Par 4 with tree lined fairway, out of bounds to the left and stream that cuts across the fairway running all the way along the hole. Only the biggest of hitters will attempt to drive the stream!



This Par 4 requires an accurate tee shot through a narrow gap in the trees, with out of bounds to the left, tree lined fairway and a tree in the centre of the fairway to avoid. The sloping green is protected by raised mounds to the front, providing a good test of your distance control.



This straight Par 4, with the river Ure running all the way along to the left and tree in the centre of the fairway requires an accurate tee shot. Trees to the right and a small, undulating green provide a good test of your approach skills.



Yellow and White Tees are required to drive over the river Ure to the narrow, rolling fairway on the other side – how much of the river you take on is up to you! A narrow approach to the green, which is protected by a huge tree to the front, pond to the right and three greenside bunkers make this a real risk and reward challenge.



Our feature lake hole, this Par 3 requires a good carry to avoid a free ball wash! Anything short will be wet and with the added difficulty of a small pond tucked away to the left of the green, this hole presents the chance of a birdie or disaster in equal measures!



A substantial dog-leg right Par 4, with out of bounds to the left, huge mound to the right and a blind approach shot for anything short make this a really testing hole. With a sloping, elevated green and greenside bunker to negotiate, only the biggest of hitters will attempt the direct route from the tee!



The shortest hole on the course, but don't be fooled by the yardage as this Par 3 is protected by a tree to the front of the green and pond to the rear, that is hidden from your view off the tee and ready to catch anything long.



A driveable, dog-leg right Par 4 to finish, with out of bounds to both sides and our enormous charity bunker waiting to collect any tee shot that attempts to take the dog-leg out and drive the green!
